




What is a 'microbiome'

A community of microorganisms in a particular environment i.e. colon or lungs

Microbiomes important to calf health





Take home messages

- Microbiomes, established in the first weeks of life, are influenced by both genetics and environment
- Diverse and stable microbiomes are essential for long-term animal health and well-being
- Microbiomes play a significant role in manifestation of both respiratory and diarrhoeal disease
